**PROGRAM:** In conjunction with the Social Science curriculum and thematic units, Ryder school will send ten (10) students on a tour of Senegal, Africa from April 14, 2001 through April 18, 2001.

## **EDUCATIONAL VALUE/OUTCOMES:** Students will:

- be able to analyze and evaluate the information acquired and then compare and contrast the two societies.
- engage in critical analysis to identify and asses specific components of Senegal's society.
- compare and contrast the social system of the United States and Africa.
- have a knowledge of the physical characteristics of the two countries.
- understand explicit and implicit meaning of the country's literature and be prepared to discuss and share information.
