REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF STANLEY ROBINSON, PORTER, CORKERY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Stanley Robinson, a porter currently assigned to Corkery Elementary School, 2510 South Kildare Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60623, with theft or unauthorized possession of school property, or use of such property for unauthorized purposes; behaviors that seriously disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off the school grounds or assigned work locations; and behaviors that grossly disrupt the orderly educational process in the classroom, in the school, and may occur on or off school grounds or assigned work location.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Stanley Robinson from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Stanley Robison has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Stanley Robinson without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
