**TERM:** The term of each agreement shall commence on January 1, 2004, and shall end June 30, 2004. Each agreement shall have two (2) options to renew for periods of one (1) year each.

**EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:** The Board shall have the right to terminate any agreement with thirty (30) days written notice.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:** Each agency will provide the following services to a minimum of nine (9) high schools: individual, group and family consulting, case management, evaluation and coordination of social services and parent training and support for students and families identified in the adjudication process as chronic absentees. Agencies shall also provide home visits, reviews and screening of students.

**DELIVERABLES:** Agencies shall provide case management which includes an assessment of student/family needs; development of a plan of services to meet identified needs; arranging, coordinating and monitoring the delivery of services to children and families; and an evaluation of the effectiveness of services provided.

**COMPENSATION:** The agencies will be paid as periodic invoices are submitted and verified, in amounts not to exceed \$350,000.00 in aggregate.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreements. Authorize the President and Secretary to execute the agreements. Authorize the Chief Education Officer to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this agreement.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: Pursuant to Section 6.2 of the Revised Remedial Plan for Minority and Women Business Enterprise Contract Participation (M/WBE Plan), the per Contract and the Category Goals method for M/WBE participation will be utilized. Thus, contracts for subsequent vendors from the pool created by this contract will be subject to compliance reviews on a contract-by-contract basis. Aggregated compliance of the vendors in the pool will be reported on a monthly basis.
