DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to Section 6 of Board Policy #95-1025-PO2 and the Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chief Executive Officer charged Steven Stokley, a watchman assigned to the Bureau of Safety and Security, 125 South Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois 60603, and Farragut Career Academy High School, 2345 South Christiana Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60623, with leaving the classroom, duty assignment, or school without permission; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 1 misconduct; repeated or flagrant acts of Group 2 misconduct; falsification of any attendance or other employment records, including, but not limited to, signing or swiping another employee's time record; and conduct unbecoming a Chicago Public Schools' employee.

The Chief Executive Officer hereby requests the dismissal of Steven Stokley from the employ of the Chicago Board of Education. Steven Stokley has been afforded a discharge hearing and the Chief Executive Officer has suspended Steven Stokley without pay.

He will be dismissed from employment immediately upon service of the notice of dismissal together with a copy of this Board Report and the charges and specifications.
