**PROGRAM:** There is a need for our students to achieve higher reading scores under the NCLB requirements. Efforts are under way for motivating students to achieve this goal. Currently, teachers are collaborating with cross-curricular ideas with emphasis on motivating students to achieve the federal benchmark for NCLB. As part of our school's mission statement, and, as part of our uniqueness of being the only public performance arts high school, in the state of Illinois, the goal of this program is to stimulate, motivate and correlate the performing arts with the core classes of English and History, which will ultimately improve students reading scores through this program. The state goals for history that students will explore are: 14, 16 and 17. Students will explore all of the state goals for English: 1, 2, 3, and 4.

**EDUCATIONAL VALUE/OUTCOMES:** The anticipated outcomes and educational value to be obtained from this program are many. The most important long-range outcome will be that students achieve higher reading scores. Student's interest and natural inquisitiveness will be carefully guided through media: books, magazine articles, poetry, interviews, the Internet, movies, film and music. Upon returning, students will present the written journals to their prospective English and History classes. Students will present oral reports as well. The media center will provide a display for the school which will include artifacts and souvenirs that students will collect while exploring the cultures, languages, geography and history. Reading scores of the students will be tracked to show how this educational tour, and, the correlating reading and writing requirement will impact reading skills.
