ESTABLISH ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES FOR LITTLE VILLAGE CAMPUS HIGH SCHOOL AND ADJUST ATTENDANCE AREA BOUNDARIES FOR MANLEY HIGH SCHOOL AND FARRAGUT HIGH SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Effective July 1, 2005, establish attendance boundaries for the Little Village Campus High School located at 3126 South Kostner Avenue. Adjust attendance area boundaries for the Manley Career Academy High School located at 2935 West Polk Street and the Farragut Career Academy High School located at 2345 South Christiana Avenue.

A Public Hearing was held on January 13, 2005 at the Board Offices located at 125 S. Clark to receive public comment on the proposed changes.

DESCRIPTION:

These changes are necessary due to overcrowding at the Farragut Career Academy High School. Reduction of overcrowding at Farragut Career Academy High School is accomplished by adjusting their attendance areas, also establishing an attendance area for the Little Village Campus High School.

Each of the four schools located at the Little Village Campus will enroll 100 students in the 2005-06 school year in grade 9. The building has a capacity of 1400; therefore, an enrollment cap will be in effect so that each grade after freshman year enrolls 84 students and each school has no more than 352 students total in grades 9 - 12.

Students residing within the Little Village attendance area who are not accepted at the Little Village Campus High School due to enrollment caps will be placed on a waiting list for admission to the campus. Students residing within the Little Village Campus High School attendance area who are not enrolled at one of the four high schools as a result of the lottery managed by the Office of Academic Enhancement will be assigned to a designated receiving school by the Office of Instruction and School Management, which shall work in conjunction with the feeder schools and the Little Village High School Placement Office with the participation of the student and parents/legal guardians. Little Village Campus boundaries will be regularly reviewed to effectuate these enrollment requirements.

These changes effect only newly enrolled ninth graders for the 2005-2006 school year, ninth and tenth grades for the 2006-2007 school year, ninth through eleventh grades for the 2007-2008 school year and ninth through twelfth grades for the 2008-2009 school year. Students currently enrolled at any of these schools, will not be required to transfer.

The Modified Desegregation Consent Decree entered on March 1, 2004 by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois in U.S. v. Chicago Board of Education, 80 C 5124 states: "CPS shall alleviate any racially and ethnically disproportionate overcrowding of school sites, to the extent practicable." Modified Consent Decree at Section I(G)(1), p. 9.

Adjust Attendance Area Boundary for Manley Career Academy High School (1460):

Grades ninth through twelfth (effective July 1, 2005);

Beginning at the City Limits and Jackson Boulevard East to Pulaski Road South to the Eisenhower Expressway East to California Avenue South to the Rail Road West to St. Louis Avenue South to Douglas Boulevard Continuing west on Douglas Boulevard to 14th Street East to City Limits North to the Starting Point.

Establish Attendance Area Boundary for Little Village Campus High School:

Grades ninth (effective July 1, 2005), Grades ninth through tenth (effective July 1, 2006), Grades ninth through eleventh (effective July 1, 2007), Grades ninth through twelfth (effective July 1, 2008);

Beginning at the Kenton Avenue (City Limits) and 14th Street
East to Kildare Avenue
South to 18th Street
East to Karlov Avenue
South to Cermak Road
East to Pulaski Road
South to the Sanitary Ship Canal
Southwest to Kenton Avenue (City Limits)
North to the Starting Point.
