## RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO REGARDING THE DISMISSAL OF JOSEPH FOREMAN, TENURED TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO WEST PULLMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-85 of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-85, a hearing was conducted before an impartial hearing officer, Lisa Salkovitz Kohn, appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the dismissal hearing afforded Joseph Foreman, the hearing officer made written findings of fact and conclusions of law, and recommended the dismissal of Joseph Foreman; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago has reviewed the posthearing briefs and hearing transcript and exhibits ("record"), along with the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation of the hearing officer regarding the dismissal charges preferred against Joseph Foreman; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago finds that the facts constitute cause and grounds for his dismissal; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago that Joseph Foreman be dismissed;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, as follows:

Section 1: After considering the hearing officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation, and after a thorough review of the entire record of the dismissal hearing, the Board of Education of

the City of Chicago adopts the recommendation of the hearing

officer.

Section 2: Joseph Foreman is hereby dismissed from his employment with

the Board of Education of the City of Chicago.

**Section3**: This Resolution shall take full force and effect upon its adoption.

**THEREFORE**, this Resolution is hereby adopted/<del>rejected</del> by the members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago on May 24, 2006.
