RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO REGARDING THE REINSTATEMENT OF FRANK LOLLINO, TENURED TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO LANE TECH HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-85 of the Illinois School Code, 105 ILCS 5/34-85, a hearing was conducted before an impartial hearing officer, Lawrence Cohen, appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, after the conclusion of the dismissal hearing afforded Lawrence Cohen, the hearing officer made written findings of fact and conclusions of law, and recommended the reinstatement of Frank Lollino; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago has reviewed the posthearing briefs and hearing transcript ("record"), along with the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation of the hearing officer regarding the dismissal charges preferred against Frank Lollino; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago finds that the facts do not constitute cause and grounds for his dismissal; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago that Frank Lollino be reinstated as a teacher at Lane Tech High School;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, as follows:

Section 1:

After considering the hearing officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation, and after a thorough review of the entire record of the dismissal hearing, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago adopts the recommendation of the hearing officer to reinstate Frank Lollino as a teacher at Lane Tech High School.

Section 2:

Based upon the hearing officer's findings that Frank Lollino violated Specifications 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Charges and Specifications against Frank Lollino, The Board of Education of the City of Chicago issues a warning resolution, 30 day suspension, and bar from any extracurricular coaching positions with the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (Opinion and Order and Warning Resolution issued under separate cover).

Section 3: This Resolution shall take full force and effect upon its adoption.

THEREFORE, this Resolution is hereby adopted/rejected by the members of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago on May 24, 2006.
