Effective July 1, 2007, adjust the attendance boundaries for the Alexander Graham Bell School, located at 3730 North Oakley Avenue; and the Audubon Elementary School, located at 3500 North Hoyne Avenue. Students currently attending these schools may continue to attend in these schools.

A public meeting was convened on February 14, 2007 at the Bell School to receive comments on the proposed boundary change.

DESCRIPTION:

These changes are necessary in order to recapture a portion of the city block, which had previously been included in the Bell School attendance area. These boundaries will supersede Bell and Audubon's attendance boundaries in Board Report 06-1025-EX3.
