## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUSPENSION OF HEALTH EXAMINATION AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR FIFTH AND SIXTH GRADERS FOR THE 2007-2008 SCHOOL YEAR

WHEREAS, the Board adopted a policy on September 28, 2005 regarding Student Health Examinations, Immunizations and Dental Examinations (Board Report 05-0928-PO2) to comply with Section 27-8.1 of the Illinois School Code ("Health Examination Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the Board's Health Examination Policy requires kindergarten students, fifth graders and ninth graders, new enrollees irrespective of grade and preschool students to meet health examination and immunization requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, effective August 24, 2007, the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS 5/27-8.1) was amended by P.A. 95-0422 to change the grade level for required student health examinations from 5<sup>th</sup> grade to 6<sup>th</sup> grade; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS 5/27-8.1) requires students to present a school with proof of immunizations at or about the same time as he or she receives the required health examination; and

**WHEREAS,** on September 4, 2007, the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) issued a notice stating that the enforcement of the new 6<sup>th</sup> grade health examination requirement will be deferred until the 2008-2009 school year as parents and guardians of 6<sup>th</sup> graders did not receive notification of this change in the law prior to the start of the 2007-2008 school year;

**WHEREAS**, the Board wishes to implement P.A. 95-0422 within the parameters provided by the ISBE notice by removing the health examination requirement for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and delaying the enforcement health examination requirement for 6th grade students for the 2007-2008 school year.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD, as follows:

- 1. The health examination and immunization requirements for 5<sup>th</sup> grade students identified in the Board's Health Examination Policy are hereby suspended for the 2007-2008 school year.
- 2. The health examination and immunization requirements for 6<sup>th</sup> graders identified in P.A. 95-0422 will not be enforced by Chicago Public Schools for the 2007-2008 school year.
- 3. The Chicago Public Schools will not exclude 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grade students from school for the failure to submit proof a health examination or proof of the required immunizations by October 15, 2007.
- 4. Except as otherwise noted in this Resolution, the Board's Health Examination Policy will remain in effect, including but not limited to provisions related to pre-school and kindergarten students, 9<sup>th</sup> grade students, transfer students and new enrollees, waivers and dental examinations.
