ADJUST THE ATTENDANCE AREAS OF BANNEKER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, MAYS ACADEMY, AND KERSHAW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND ESTABLISH LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL VOTING BOUNDARIES FOR KERSHAW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That effective at the end of the 2007-08 school year, the Chicago Board of Education adjust the attendance boundaries of the Benjamin Banneker Elementary School (Unit 6880), located at 6656 South Normal Boulevard, Benjamin E. Mays Academy Elementary School (Unit 7150) located at 838 West Marquette Road, and the Joshua D. Kershaw Elementary School (Unit 4270), located at 6450 South Lowe Avenue. Kershaw Elementary will no longer have an attendance area but will accept students citywide.

A public hearing was convened on December 21, 2007 at the Chicago Public Schools, Central Office to discuss and receive comments on these matters.

DESCRIPTION:

The Chief Executive Office recommends that Kershaw Elementary accept students citywide. A public hearing was convened on December 21, 2007, pursuant to proper notice to receive public comment on the CEO's proposal. A hearing moderator received comments and supporting documents at the hearing and has prepared a hearing report regarding the CEO's proposal. After receiving the hearing report, the CEO has determined to recommend that the Board of Education cease to maintain attendance boundaries at the Kershaw Elementary at the end of the 2007-2008 school year and reassign Kershaw's attendance area to the Banneker Elementary School and Mays Academy Elementary School. Kershaw's former attendance boundary will become its local school council voting boundaries. These changes are applicable only to incoming students and do not affect students currently enrolled at these schools. No students currently attending Banneker, Mays or Kershaw will be required to transfer. Transportation will no longer be provided from the former boundaries.
