Establish a charter school overlay boundary for the CICS - Ellison Charter High School, located at 8001 S. Honore Street. The charter school overlay attendance boundary described below may be used for the enrollment and/or lottery procedures beginning with the 2008-2009 school year.

A public meeting was convened on Friday, November 16, 2007 at the Board Chambers to discuss and receive comments on the proposed charter school boundary.

DESCRIPTION:

This board report is necessary in order to establish a charter school (overlay) attendance boundary for the CICS-Ellison High School.

Section 27A-4(d) of the Illinois Charter Schools Law authorizes the Board to designate attendance boundaries for certain charter schools to relieve overcrowding or to better serve low-income and at-risk students. Students residing within the attendance boundary of the CICS – Ellison Charter High School will be given priority for enrollment, but will not be required to attend the Charter school. Students who do not wish to attend the CICS – Ellison Charter High School will be eligible to enroll at Hirsch High School, Hyde Park High School, or Bogan High School.

Beginning at Western Avenue and the Belt RR (at 75th Street) East to Paulina Street South to 83rd Street West to Western Avenue North to the Starting Point
