## APPROVE THE RELOCATION OF LANGSTON HUGHES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

## THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

Approve the relocation of the Langston Hughes Elementary School (unit 8060, school ID 610368) ("Hughes"), to a new building located at 240 W. 104<sup>th</sup> Street.

## **DESCRIPTION:**

Langston Hughes Elementary School was previously located at 226 West 104<sup>th</sup> Street. Prior to the beginning of the 2007-08 school year, the Hughes school faculty and students were relocated to three temporary locations to allow for the demolition and construction of a new school facility. Students, staff and administration were relocated to 10414 South State Street, 10540 South Morgan Street, and 10211 South Crandon Avenue for the 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 school years. The demolition of the former building began in October 2007 and the new facility is expected to open prior to the 2009-2010 school year. This relocation is contingent upon the completion of the new school facility prior to the beginning of the 2009-2010 school year.

The existing Hughes attendance area boundaries are not affected by the school's relocation to the 240 W. 104<sup>th</sup> Street facility.

All Hughes administration and staff will be relocated to the new Hughes building and no students will be transferred or reassigned as a result of this recommendation.

Upon Hughes' relocation to the new building and consolidation with Davis Developmental Center, as specified in Board Report 09-0225-EX19, Hughes will provide an Early Childhood Special Education program.
