ORIGIANAL LEASE: The original lease agreement (authorized by Board Report 06-0426-OP2) is for a term commencing May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007, with Tenant having the option to renew the lease for 2 additional 1-year terms. The original lease was renewed for a period commencing May 1, 2007 and ending April 30, 2008 (authorized by Board Report 07-0425-OP1). The original lease was further renewed for a term commencing May 1, 2008 and ending April 30, 2009 (authorized by Board Report 08-0423-OP2).

RENEWAL TERM: By mutual consent of the parties, the lease agreement shall be renewed for a term commencing May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010.

GROSS RENT: Gross Rent for the renewal term shall be as follows:

Authorize the General Counsel to execute all ancillary documents required to administer or effectuate this lease renewal agreement.

FINANCIAL: Credit to the General Fund.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness – The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics – The Board's Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability – The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s)
